Livable wages, helping hands, people utilizing services, circle (all people supporting each other), cross pollination, youth and young adults who grow up here want to stay here, people are openly active and outdoors in their communities, people are comfortable at home, smiling faces, families talking to each other, playing together, connecting, community meals (people sitting with each other), talking communicating, connecting without substances, everyone divers (all ages, races, ethnicities, all abilities, all socioeconomic); people facing challenging conversations and needs and collectively coming together to make positive change, plenty of places to seek and receive help.
